



QASC's 11th Annual Kids' Safety-in-the-Car Poster Contest

It's that time of year again! Don't miss the opportunity to participate in the 2011 QASC Kids' **'Safety-in-the-Car'** poster contest. Help the QASC promote community safety at school, in the home, and at work by participating in the poster contest. The contest runs from March 14, 2011, through March 28, 2011. All entries **must be** submitted to your school office by March 28. Winners will be announced Monday, April 4, 2011, on the www.qasc.org/http://qasc.etcdevelopment.com/community-safety/safety-posters web site.

The contest is open to children in grades 4th, 5th, and 6th. Four winners will be selected from each grade for posters that **best illustrate** the theme **Safety-in-the Car**. Each winner will receive a \$25 cash prize and their poster will be displayed on the QASC web site.

Poster Contest Rules

1. Children in grades 4, 5, and 6 are eligible to participate in the contest.
2. The poster **drawing must relate to the theme 'Safety-in-the-Car' and should illustrate an example of safety in a car**. Children are encouraged to be creative.
3. The finished poster must be on plain 8.5 X 11 inch paper (portrait or landscape) using crayons, markers, colored pencils, or paints.
4. All drawings must be an individual effort and be free-hand originals - no traced pictures, computer graphics or printouts.
5. **Only one entry per child is allowed.**
6. Student name, school name, grade, and teacher must be printed on the **backside** of the poster.
7. All entries become property of the QASC once submitted.
